1971-1975: Höhenrain primary school; 1975-1977: Feldkirchen secondary school; 1977-1981: Wirtschaftsschule Alpenland business school Bad Aibling; *Mittlere Reife* [intermediate school leaving certificate].

District Chairman of the *Bavarian Hotel and Restaurant Association* (BGH) for Munich-Upper Bavaria; Member of the State executive committee of the BGH; District Chairman of the *Association for Maintaining the Bavarian Culture of Hospitality* (VEBWK) with more than 10,000 members!

Divorced; Father of two sons aged 32 and 24; Landlord of guest house in the seventh generation of ownership with partner Doris; Family-owned since 1732; From a family of landlords and butchers from Upper and Lower Bavaria with roots back to the 11th century; Housing development entrepreneur. Lettings to families with children or single parents prioritised (currently more than 20 children in rented apartments).

1981 Graduation from Bad Aibling business college, achieving the best of year results three years in a row; Joined the Junge Union (*Young Conservatives*) as a school student; School Spokesman.

Bavarian State Parliament

1983: Completion of apprenticeship as a Butcher with state award; 1983: Joined the Christian Social Union; Secretary in the Executive Committee; 1985: Elected 1st Chairman of Feldkirchen-Bruckmühl-Aying-Irschenberg Trade Association as the youngest Chairman in Germany; Member of the District Executive since 1985; 1987: Elected as then youngest CSU Local Chairman in Bavaria; 1987: Qualification as a Master Butcher as best in training; 1988: Death of father and takeover of family business.

1990: Member of the District Executive of the BHG; 1992: Member of the District Executive of the *Haus- und Grundbesitzerverein* home and property owners' association; 1996: First election to the *IHK Parlament der Wirtschaft* general assembly; Member of the Retail and Tourism Committee and Tax Committee; 1996: Elected to the District Council; CSU Parliamentary Group Spokesman until 1997; Vice Parliamentary Group Spokesman until 2002; Business Spokesman.

1998: Founding member of the Working Group of Business Associations for Rosenheim West; Initiator of the New Year's reception for Business Associations with keynote speakers from the worlds of politics and science; 2000: Elected President of BGH Rosenheim Town and Country; 2001 and 2006: Re-elected to the IHK as Gastronomy Representative; 2002: Re-elected to the District Council and elected as 2nd Mayor.

2004: Appointment as an Honorary Judge for Employment Law; 2004: Managing director / founder of the company *Bürgersolargesellschaft Feldkirchen-Weyarn*; 2005: Parental governor at Bruckmühl secondary school; 2006: Elected BGH District Chairman for Obb-Munich and member of the state board; 2007: Founder and State Chairman of VEBWK with over 83,000 members, at the time the third biggest association in Bavaria.

2007: Founder and chairman of the *Pro Citizen Free Voters* movement; Expulsion procedure as the then Local CSU Chairman (because I had worked with Free Voter groups and the SPD), followed by resignation!

2008: Re-elected to the District Council with the most direct votes of all candidates; Immediately second strongest grouping with *Pro Citizen* in the District Council of the greater municipality; 2010: Elected member of the federal board of DEHOGA Hotel and restaurant association Germany; 2010: Referendum speaker "*For Freedom and Tolerance*"; 2011: Appointed as Honorary Financial Judge to Munich Court of Finance; 2014: Re-elected to the District Council with the most direct votes of all candidates.

2014: Elected Vice District Chairman of the AfD Rosenheim; 2015: Elected District Chairman of the AfD Rosenheim; 2015: Named by the State Executive of the AfD as Economics Commissioner for the AfD; 2018: Elected District Chairman of the AfD Upper Bavaria; 2018: Elected lead candidate of the AfD for Upper Bavaria in the elections to the Bavarian State Parliament.
